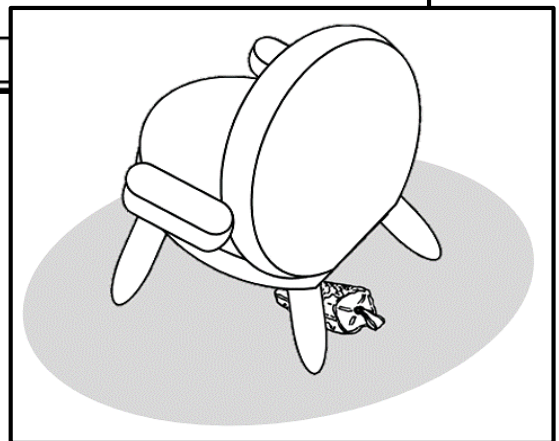
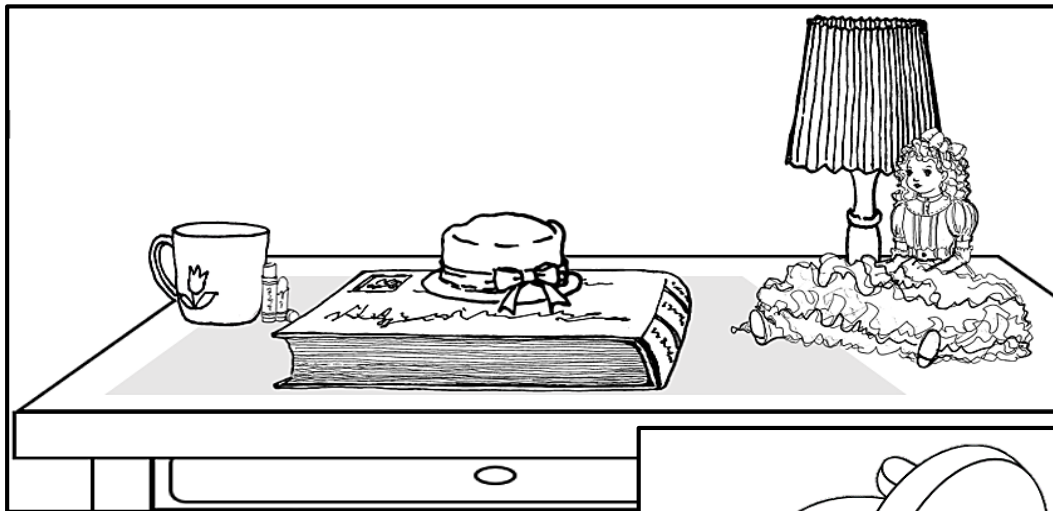
測驗試題
